


# "INTERCONNECTION OF THE NATIONAL TRANSMISSION SYSTEM WITH THE INTERNATIONAL GAS TRANSMISSION PIPELINES AND REVERSE FLOW AT ISACCEA (RO)"

## 1. PROJECT NAME

Interconnection of the national transmission system with the international gas transmission pipelines and reverse flow at Isaccea (RO)



### 2. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project (green line) aims at ensuring the bi-directional flow towards Bulgaria between the National Gas Transmission System (NTS) and the Transit 1 pipeline to Bulgaria, under normal operating conditions; some of the pipes belonging to the NTS need rehabilitation works, the construction of a connection pipeline is also necessary between the Transit 1 pipeline to Bulgaria and the NTS at GMS Isaccea, a compressor station at Siliştea and bi-directional flow with Ukraine implying some works at the GMS Isaccea.



# Total estimated investment value = Euro 65 milllion

# The estimated completion deadline is 2019.

The project will consist in the following:

- Modernization and extension of the Silistea compressor station;
- Modernization and extension of the Onești compressor station;
- · Modifications within the Isaccea metering station;
- repair of the Cosmeşti Oneşti (66.2 km) and Siliştea Şendreni (11.3 km) pipeline sections.

The project was included under number **6.15**. on the second PCI List of the European Union adopted on 18 November 2015.
